
Dear Sir or Madam:

The recipient of the award will receive a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00. All applicants must be a senior in a high school located within New London County, with an expectation to graduate on time and an expectation of attending a college, university or other qualifying institution the following school year. The award recipient will be required to show proof of acceptance to a qualifying college or university prior to receiving the award. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), must be accepted to a qualifying college and/or university and must demonstrate a commitment to public service and community involvement.

The deadline by which to submit applications will be April 15, 2016.
